

FOG DESIGN+ART ANNOUNCES GALLERIES EXHIBITING IN 2023 FAIR

San Francisco, CA (September 30, 2022) – FOG Design+Art is excited to announce that the ninth edition of the fair will be held January 19 - 22, 2023 at Fort Mason Center for Arts and Culture in San Francisco. The fair will open with a Preview Gala on Wednesday, January 18 benefitting the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art's (SFMOMA) education and exhibitions program. The fair will be co-chaired by philanthropists and collectors Komal Shah & Gaurav Garg.

FOG Design+Art brings together an international roster of leading contemporary design and art galleries, offering visitors the opportunity to experience the best of art and design from around the world all in one place. The 2023 fair will include 45 booths featuring 48 galleries from Chicago, London, Los Angeles, Mexico City, Milan, Monte Carlo, New York, and San Francisco, among others, with longtime participants and a selection of galleries exhibiting for the first time, including: Casemore Kirkeby (San Francisco), gió Marconi (Milan), Marc Selwyn Fine Art (Los Angeles), Night Gallery (Los Angeles), Nilufar Gallery (Milan), and Nonaka-Hill (Los Angeles).

"We are excited to present the 2023 edition of the fair, bringing together a suite of returning favorites and first-time exhibitors from around the world," said steering committee member Douglas Durkin. "Each year our list of exhibitors somehow manages to top the year before. With carefully curated exhibitions and really thoughtful presentations of truly outstanding works for art and design, we couldn't be more thrilled with this year's presentation. FOG is such an important part of the cultural vitality of San Francisco, and we feel so honored to be able to bring such an outstanding fair to our city this year, and to anchor the always fantastic SF Art Week."

In addition to the exhibitions on view, the fair will once again present **FOG Talks**, a programming series that explores ideas and issues relevant to the fields of art, design, technology, and our contemporary world, in the FOG Theater. The programs are all included free with fair admission.

FOG Fair is overseen by a steering committee of San Franciscans with a deep commitment to the cultural fabric of the city: Douglas Durkin, Stanlee Gatti, Katie Paige, Sarah Wendell Sherrill, and Susan Swig. The fair was established in 2014 to create an international platform to champion art and design in the Bay Area.

Continuing FOG's long-standing support of SFMOMA, the Preview Gala supports the museum's exhibitions and education programs, while FOG Forum specifically raises funds for its Architecture and Design department.
