San Francisco, CA (January 19, 2023)—Last night at the Fort Mason Center for Arts and Culture, the 2023 edition of FOG Design+Art opened with its annual Preview Gala. The ninth edition of FOG Design+Art is open to the public from Thursday, January 19 through Sunday, January 22. In addition to the 45 booth presentations of 48 pre-eminent galleries in the fields of modern and contemporary art and design, FOG features a dynamic line up of public conversations, included with fair admission. Bringing together leaders in the fields of art, design, climate activism, and technology, FOG Talks offer visitors the opportunity to engage deeply with some of today's most relevant issues. The programming events, curated by Susan Swig, will take place throughout the run of the fair.

In addition, FOG is presenting a captivating installation by Bay Area artist Jenny Sharaf in the fair's entryway. *Elevated Conversation* is an immersive experience that invites visitors to lounge on

custom furniture upholstered in fabric painted by Sharaf, and to engage in conversation with one another and with the artist. The installation will feature large-scale paintings as well as ceramic platters and teacups created by Sharaf.
